Wednesday, October 6, 2021, The Second Day

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament after Mass

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament with Prayers for the Holy Souls in Purgatory
followed by Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament

Thursday, October 7, 2021, The Third Day
(The Feast of Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary)

Exposition, Procession and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament
8:00 p.m. The close of 40 Hours. Church is closed for the night
